

Entwistle is pleased to announce the sale of a superb **Middle Period Benin Head** to the **Museum of Fine Arts, Houston**.

Originally acquired by the noted connoisseur, pioneer of modernism and painter A.E. Gallatin from Spink of London in 1948, the head had remained in the possession of his heirs until its sale to Houston.

The sale was negotiated by Roberta Entwistle in March of this year.
